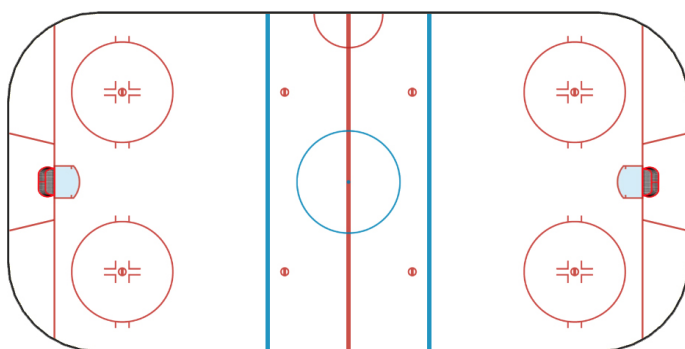
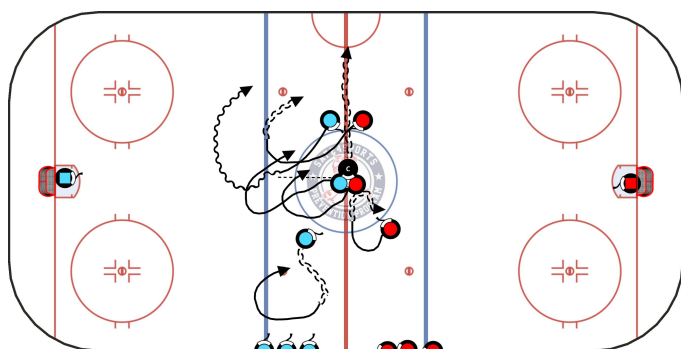

DESCRIPTION:

This full ice, 3-on-3, 4-on-4, or 5-on-5 game challenges the scoring team to retrieve the puck from the net that they scored and then attack their starting end. A new defensive squad jumps in from the benches when a goal is scored against. Quick changes and scramble to defend are an exciting component to this continuous game. Add game rules to add complexity such as pass over line rule, dump rule etc. Odd man situations can be created as well.

KEYPOINTS:

Even player situations defensively and offensively with land marking are great teachables in this game. Cue players in reading the rush, protecting the corridor, deflecting the attack, steering and slowing attack (rush) to gain support defensively. Offensive players can gain from specific cues on creating ice and "using the ice"; the length, width and depth of the attack.
